Going Deeper

1. Look over the various aspects of the Day of Atonement in Leviticus 16. What are some of the rituals that you see that prefigure what Jesus did on the cross?

2. Read Isaiah 53. As you look over this chapter, how does it contain ideas found in both the Day of Atonement and the crucifixion of Jesus?

3. In Hebrews 10:22 we are commanded to "draw near." Paraphrase this verse like you were explaining it to a new believer. How does Leviticus 16 help us understand the imagery of washing and sprinkling?

4. In Hebrews 10:23 we are commanded to "hold fast." Paraphrase this verse like you were explaining it to a new believer. Do you feel like you ever "waver?" If so, how would you describe your "wavering?" What are some of the ways that you combat wavering in the faith--what advice would you give someone who is wavering?

5. In Hebrews 10:24 we are commanded to "consider how." Paraphrase this verse like you were explaining it to a new believer. What commands in verse 25 work to accomplish the command in verse 24?

6. Do you feel that believers today feel the meeting together of Christians is important? Why or why not? What obstacles exist today that stand in the way of believers meeting together?
